1. The college shall submit the applications for issue of Eligibility certificates in respect of Foreign Nationals before: 17.08.2019. The application received after this date will not be considered.
2. The last date for obtaining of permission from University for admission to III semester on transfer basis from other colleges/Universities and readmission to III semester is before: 10.08.2019.
3. Principals are requested to forward the representations of the students seeking permission for readmission and transfer admission along with no due certificate, no objection certificates (from both Colleges) and photo copies of previous semester marks card to the university.
4. Principals are requested to make admissions strictly in accordance with the Eligibility condition and also as per the sanctioned intake for each course.
5. The Guidelines for completion of degree circulated vide circular No: Aca-II/UGC-Span period/Deg./2015-16, Bangalore University dated: 18.11.2015 may be displayed on the college Notice Board.
6. The Principals should consider the marks cards of the qualifying exams of the recognized Boards only (Copy enclosed). The list of recognized Boards is also available in the University Website i.e. [www.bangaloreuniversity.ac.in](http://www.bangaloreuniversity.ac.in). Any marks card other than notified shall not be considered.
7. Regulation Governing the Choice Based Credit System (Semester Scheme) in the Undergraduate Courses in the Faculties of Arts, science and Commerce shall be followed for Academic year 2019-20
8. Principals are requested to allot the invigilation work to the teachers of major subjects such as Commerce, Management, English, Mathematics, Economics, etc., in the beginning of the theory examination and relieve them immediately for evaluation work.
9. Principals are further requested to compulsorily collect the evaluation attendance certificates from all the teachers who attended evaluation work in different subjects and produce them before the Local Inquiry Committee for verification at the time of visit.
10. During vacation, it is mandatory for teachers to undertake theory valuation and practical examination related work assigned by the University. Otherwise disciplinary action will be initiated for dereliction of duty, in the case of University, Government, and Aided College teachers and in the case of Unaided colleges attending to the examination work are one of the conditions to continue affiliation.
11. Submission of any required document after the date of approval will not be considered for approval.
12. The marks card issued by NWAC; USA Diploma certificate is not considered as equivalent to 12<sup>th</sup> standard for admission to UG courses.
13. The colleges have to collect and remit the fee as prescribed by the University.
14. The Principals are requested to adhere to the above schedule of Calendar of Events and follow the Rules and Regulations strictly.
15. The Principals of colleges are required to remit the admission and Examination fees of 1<sup>st</sup> Year (1<sup>st</sup> & II<sup>nd</sup> sem) in respect of SC/ST Students if not already remitted to the University.
